Boils The Egyptians made the Jews work hard heating water for them, so Hashem afflicted them with boils so that they could not bathe at all, neither in hot nor in cold water.	שְׁחִין	
Hail The Egyptians used to stone the Jews, so Hashem punished them with the plague of hail. The hail crashed down like giant rocks upon the Egyptians and their buildings.	דָבָ	
Locusts The locusts came upon the Egyptians as a punishment for all the hard work they made the Jews do for them in their vineyards. This was מִינְה בְּנֶגֶּד מִינְה because the locusts destroyed all of the fruit that had grown as a result of the Jews' hard work.	אַרְבֶּה	
Darkness Because the Egyptians imprisoned the Jews in dark, unpleasant dungeons, Hashem punished them with the plague of darkness.	חשֶׁדְּ	
Killing of the Firstborn The Egyptians wanted to kill the Jews, whom Hashem calls His firstborn (Shemot 4:22 - "בְּנִי בְּבֹרִי יִשְׂרָאֵל"), so Hashem punished them by killing all of their firstborn.	מַכַּת בְּכוֹרוֹת
