<b>The אַרְבָּעָה מִיָּנִים</b>		
<b>Date palm</b> branch: resembles the <b>spine</b> . The date has a good taste but no smell, so the lulav symbolizes the person who has <b>Torah knowledge but not good deeds</b> .	לוּלָב	_____
<b>Citron</b> : resembles the <b>heart</b> . The "Etrog" has both a pleasant taste and a pleasant smell, symbolizing one who possesses <b>both knowledge of Torah and good deeds</b> .	אֶתְרוֹג	_____
<b>3 Myrtle</b> branches: resemble the <b>eyes</b> . The "Hadas" has a pleasant smell only, and symbolizes the person who has <b>good deeds but not Torah</b> .	הַדָּסִים	_____
<b>2 Willow</b> branches: resemble the <b>lips</b> . The "Aravah" has neither a pleasant taste nor a pleasant smell, and symbolizes the person who has <b>neither Torah nor good deeds</b> .	עֲרָבוֹת	_____
