Jewish Life (1)

It is a מַנְהַג to make a Se'udat Mitzvah (a meal connected with the performance of a mitzvah) on the Shabbat evening after the birth of a baby boy. We have a to welcome (שַׁלוֹם) the newborn boy (דֶּבָר male). A deeper meaning is given by the Rabbis. We are taught that before a child is born he is taught the entire Torah. However, as soon as he enters the air of this world, an angel comes and strikes him on his mouth, causing him to *forget* the entire Torah. We come in order to remember the Torah learning that the child שַׁלוֹם וַכַּר was given before he was born and encourage him to spend his life involved in Torah.

The בְּרִית מִילָה is performed on a Jewish boy when he is eight days old, even if the eighth day is יום כפור or יום כפור. Sometimes the בָּרִית מִילָה will be postponed, on medical advice, until the baby is healthier and stronger. The Brit Milah is a sign of the closeness between Hashem and the Jewish People. The בַּרִית מִילָה also has the effect of weakening the יצר הרע and preparing the child for serving Hashem.

Pidyon Ha'Ben, the "redemption of the first born son," takes place when a baby is at least 31 days old, and involves "buying him back from a Kohen" with **five silver coins.** Originally, all first born were supposed to be the special servants (of Hashem, בֹהַנִּים, but they lost this special responsibility to the בֹּהָנִים, at the חַטְא הָעֵגֶל at the (sin of the golden calf). Only the לויים did not get involved with the תטא העגל. Hashem decreed that all בֹחֵנִים would now come from the tribe of לַנִי

According to הַלְכַה (Jewish law) a woman becomes obligated to keep the Mitzvot (becomes Bat Mitzvah) at the age of 12 and a man becomes obligated to keep the Mitzvot (becomes Bar Mitzvah) at the age of 13. We usually have special celebrations to mark these important occasions.
