1. An oath contradicting an obvious fact, for example, swearing that a stone is gold.

- 2. An oath stating an obvious fact, like swearing that a stone is a stone.
- 3. An oath not to perform a mitzvah, for example, not to put on tefillin.
- 4. An oath to do something impossible.
